Customer Information China RoHS

An update of the China RoHS Standard “Measures for Restriction of the Use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Products” became effective as of July 1, 2016. As of this date, all electrical and electronic Products fall within the scope of China RoHS regulation.

The China RoHS requirements are implemented in two phases:

Phase 1: Declaration and labelling according to SJ/T 11364-2014

All electrical and electronic products must be labeled according to this standard and a declaration must be provided for them as of July 1, 2016.

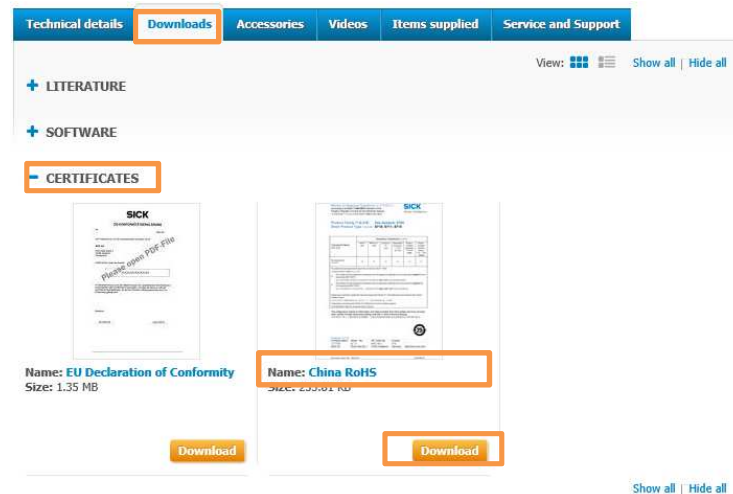

1. Enter the article number in the search bar:



2. Click *Downloads* → *Certificates* → download the “China RoHS Declaration”



The China ROHS-Declaration is available for all electronic products within the scope of China RoHS. Please note that electronic components that are designed to be embedded into an electronic product do not require a label or a declaration.

Products shipped by SICK to China will be labeled with the EFUP label. The label will be either on the product or on the product package. EFUP means “**Environment Friendly Use Period**” and is defined as a period in which hazardous substances contained in electrical and electronic products will not leak out or change suddenly under normal conditions of use, and the use of the products will not cause environmental pollution or personal and property damage.


**Phase 2:
Complying with substance restrictions**

A so-called “**Compliance Management Catalog**” published by the Chinese government defines the products or product categories that must comply with the substance restriction limits set out in the standard. The first catalog was released in March 2018. As at this date, **no SICK products fall within the scope** of the aforementioned catalog.
